Partner Highlight - Panhandle Community Services





Panhandle Community Services (PCS) is a community action agency that services the top 26 counties in the Texas Panhandle. Our mission is to work as a community leader and partner in the Texas Panhandle to change the lives of low-income people by bridging the gap from poverty to self-sufficiency. We do much for the community, and many families can benefit from our services. PCS has 12 offices located across the Texas Panhandle and each office is staffed to answer programmatic questions.

Most of our programs are federally and state-funded, with a small portion of private funding. Our social media is active, and program updates are sent out regularly through this platform. Our most extensive program at PCS is the transportation program. It employs about half of our staff. Transportation Buses can be seen around the Panhandle almost every hour of the day; the most popular rides are medical rides, most of which insurance covers the cost of the rides. Other services PCS offers are Utility Assistance, HUD housing, Family Development program, Weatherization, Career Coaching, Emergency Assistance for Veterans, Earned Income Tax Credit assistance (currently assisting families with tax help), AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP program, and Health Navigator program. Our Health Navigators are federally certified and assist individuals applying for Marketplace and Medicaid health insurance.

As a Community Action Agency, our promise is to change people's lives, embody a spirit of hope, improve communities, and make America a better place to live. We care about the entire community and are dedicated to helping people help themselves and each other.
